The Fell Runners Association – Annual General Meeting 10th July 2016 Treasurer's Report on the Financial Year 2015

1. Company Formalities

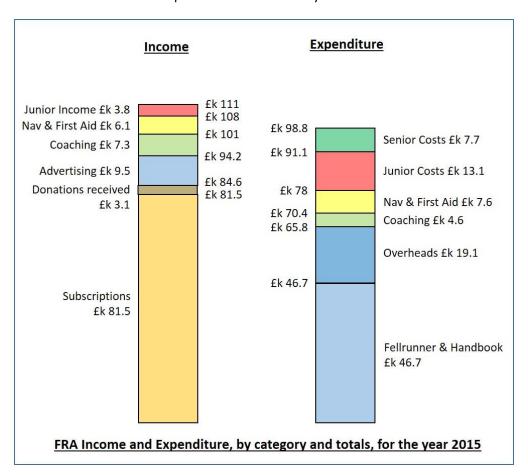
The attached accounts for 2015 were examined and approved by the elected Auditor (Mike Welford). Following approval at this AGM an abbreviated version of the accounts complying with the regulations will be filed at Companies House.

Part of the business of the AGM is to elect an auditor for the 2016 accounts, and the Committee propose that Mike Welford should again be elected.

2. Results for 2015

The FRA received around £111k in income, of which membership subscriptions formed by far the largest component, followed by advertising revenue from the Fellrunner and Handbook, and subscriptions we received from the courses we ran. The coaching and navigation courses continued as usual, and in 2015 an additional course, in Wilderness First Aid, was added to the list, bringing in a small additional income. We also received about £3.1k in donations from members who chose to add a donation to their subscription via the SIEntries system.

Our spending was around £98k, of which the costs of the Fellrunner and Handbook made up nearly half, followed by our overhead costs including the fees payable to SIEntries as part of the new on-line membership system. The cost of running our courses amounted to around £12k. We also continued to support Junior and Senior events, for example by paying for portable toilets for Championship races. Our expenditure included a donation of £500 to the National Trust 'Fix the Fells' appeal.



The overall surplus of £13k provides a useful contribution to our resources which became very depleted prior to increasing the subscriptions at the end of 2014. We see no major additional expenditure on the horizon, and so have good reason to hope that the FRA can continue to function without further subscription increases for some time.
