The Fell Runners Association - Annual General Meeting 17th June 2017 Treasurer's Report on the Financial Year 2016

1. Company Formalities

The attached accounts for 2016 were examined and approved by the elected Auditor (Mike Welford). Following approval at this AGM an abbreviated version of the accounts complying with the regulations will be filed at Companies House.

Part of the business of the AGM is to elect an Auditor for the 2017 accounts, and the Committee propose that Mike Welford should again be elected.

2. Results for 2016


Our last financial year (the calendar year 2016) was a good year in money terms, in that we slightly increased our income without spending a whole lot more, giving a surplus of around £21k.

Subscription income went up slightly as our membership increased.

We collected a lot more income from Junior events, mainly contributions from UKA, Scotland, Wales and both parts of the island of Ireland for the Junior Home International, which we staged in Keswick, but this additional income was balanced by the costs we incurred for the event.

Advertising income from the Fellrunner and also from the Handbook fell slightly.

Coaching was very well supported last year, with more courses run than ever, which reflects in the coaching income and expenditure.



Our spending excluding the JHI was fairly stable overall, with the Fellrunner and Handbook printing and postage costs dominating our outgoings. Our overheads last year were high, reflecting the costs of administering the subs collection system through the change-over to on-line; this will reduce quite a bit this year. Senior expenditure includes the 'Do', and also the payments the FRA makes to race organisers for our Championship races.

The overall surplus of £21k provides a useful contribution to our resources which became much depleted prior to increasing the subscriptions at the end of 2014. If inflation of our costs (for example printing and postage) does not increase too much we should be able to keep the subscriptions at the current level for some time..
